

## PROFESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

### Resources and Conditions

FGV Europe provides a unique and dynamic environment where diverse fields of expertise and activities mix. The “Professional Fellowship Program” entitles selected fellows to participate in the consulting projects and knowledge sharing activities of FGV Europe in Brazil and Europe. Fellows will be granted access to the FGV Network comprising international public and private decision-makers and professionals from similar specialist fields. To this end, fellows are provided with timely access to relevant events and publications, as well as other resources as needed. Fellows are strongly encouraged to proactively connect and collaborate with collaborators and other fellows. Each fellow will be matched to at least one mentor from their field of interest. This mentor will usually be a project leader based at FGV’s headquarters in Rio de Janeiro. Fellows should have a clear idea on which topics and projects they would like to work prior to arriving. This will be discussed during the interview phase of the application process. FGV Fellows are nominated for an unlimited period of time and their engagement is voluntary. They are not considered employees and will not receive any payment for participating in the “Professional Fellowship Program” of FGV Europe.

### Eligibility

30-45 years old; Fluency in English a must, fluency in Portuguese desirable; At least five years relevant work experience in government offices, private companies and business networks, multilateral organizations and networks, social organizations and NGOs, universities and research institutions; Demonstrated leadership and collaborative skills.

### Application and Nomination

The application process is two-fold: Interested professionals first send a motivation letter and CV to the representation office of FGV Europe in Cologne. Eligible applicants then are invited for a personal or phone interview. Fellows are officially nominated by the executive director of FGV Europe in Rio de Janeiro. As part of the nomination process, the Fellow signs a declaration of membership, through which he accepts the framework conditions for the “Professional Fellowship Program” of FGV Europe. Having signed the declaration of membership, the Fellow in question will be entered into the List of FGV Europe Fellows and published with a profile on this website. Following the nomination and the signing of the declaration of membership, the Fellow shall be entitled to bear the designation “FGV Fellow”.
